Contest Information

The Contest is run under the rules of the RSPBA and is administered by the Ayrshire, Dumfries-shire and Galloway Branch of the RSPBA.

The draw for order of play will take place on Saturday 26th June 2010.

Bands must register their presence between 1pm and 2pm at the Officials Accommodation on the day.

The Contest starts at 2.00pm prompt.

Grade 2 Bands will submit 1 selection of 4-6 minutes duration. £6.00

Grade 3 Bands will submit 1 selection of 3-5 minutes duration. £5.00

Grade 4 Bands will submit 1 selection of 2 ¾ - 4 ½ minutes duration in March rhythm. £4.00

Adult Drum Majors £2.00

Juvenile Drum Majors £1.00

Bands will be allowed to play up one grade, but as this is a pre-draw Contest, bands must be pre-entered to play up prior to the draw.

Band Representatives are responsible for their Band being at the Final Tuning Point.

Any band may be asked to play for the Drum Majors. Failure to adhere to this could result in disqualification.

The Annan Riding of the Marches Committee requests that all bands take part in the Massed Pipe Bands Parade from the Fish Cross to the Market Square, where the Prize Giving Ceremony will take place.

Bands will be presented with a list of the Parade Order when reporting.

Assembly time at the Fish Cross is 6pm and Bands will move off at 6.15pm SHARP.
