

# WORLD SOLO DRUMMING COMPETITION

## RULES

1. All competitors must be registered members of an RSPBA pipe band or Overseas Pipe Band association that is registered with the RSPBA.
2. All competitors must wear band uniform.
3. An entrants' competitive section will be determined by his/her age as of **1<sup>st</sup> NOVEMBER 2010.** These are as follows.

Juvenile Section 1: Under 13 years  
Juvenile Section 2: 13, 14 & 15 years  
Juvenile Section 3: 16 & 17 years  
Adult Sections: 18 years and over

#### 4. **Playing requirements**

All competitors must start their performance with two 3-pace rolls

**Juvenile Section 1:** Four parts of Quick March, in any time signature.

**Juvenile Section 2:** March, Strathspey and Reel, each tune a minimum of four parts, to be played without stopping in between tunes.

**Juvenile Section 3:** March, Strathspey and Reel, each tune a minimum of four parts, to be played without stopping in between tunes.

#### **Adult Qualifying Heats and Semi Final**

1. Submit two March, Strathspey and Reel sets, each tune minimum of four parts.
2. In Qualifying Heat play MSR of own choice.
3. In Semi Final draw on start line for set to play.

#### **Adult Final**

##### **Section One:**

March, Strathspey and Reel. To play the set not drawn in the immediate preceding round. Each tune minimum of four parts, set to be played without stopping in between tunes.

##### **Section Two:**

Hornpipe and Jig, each tune minimum of four parts, to be played without stopping in between tunes.

5. Entry Fees

Juvenile Section One:	£4.00 per competitor
Juvenile Section Two:	£5.00 per competitor
Juvenile Section Three:	£7.00 per competitor
Adult Section:	£15 per competitor

**\*Entry Fees are non returnable\***

All entry fees must be submitted together with the completed entry form and attachments for the entry to be valid.

6 Please note

It is intended that all Juvenile Sections and Adult Qualifying Heats will be held in the morning, and the Adult Semi-Finals and Adult Final will be held in the afternoon, although this may change depending on the number of entrants.

The top 12 competitors from the year 2010, Adult World Solo Drumming Championship, will automatically be seeded to the semi-final stage of the 2011 competition and need ONLY apply for that section. All other adult competitors should apply for the Adult Qualifying Heats.
