Music Board – Competition Procedures

Grade 1 Worlds Draw Principle

Grade 1 World Championships Draw Procedure:

- The draw will be made based on the principle of 1 competition – i.e. 25 Bands = 1 to 25.
- When all Pre-qualifiers are identified, they will be deleted from the “Original Draw”.
- This identifies the participants in the Qualifying Round and Order of Play.
- The Grade 1 Qualifying Draw has therefore been established.
- The Edited Draw, with times, will be posted on the Website and also issued to the appropriate Bands.
- On conclusion of the Qualifier, all Non-Qualifiers will be deleted from the “Original Draw”.
- This identifies the draw in the Final and the Order of Play.
- Information for Bands who qualify for Final will be displayed in “Draw Order” and will also define time of play.
