## Music Board – Education – National Activity

### Instructors Course 2009

The Music Board has arranged an Instructors Course for 28<sup>th</sup>/29<sup>th</sup> March 2009 which will be held at the RSPBA Head Quarters. Practical experience will follow with a concluding course planned for September/October 2009.

The Course has therefore 3 Parts:

Part 1 – will focus on will focus on the basic concepts of the learning process, skills required by an Instructor lesson planning and the creation and use of visual aids.

Part 2 – will be a planned experience with individual candidates participating in practical instructional opportunities under the guidance of an approved RSPBA Instructor. Here candidates will demonstrate their underpinning knowledge in both Theory and Practical Skills in their chosen discipline.

Part 3 – will consolidate the activity and skills gained in Parts 1 and 2 and assess candidates overall performance against the required standards for approval and registration as an RSPBA Instructor.

15 Candidates will participate and the quality of CV's received gives an opportunity that will see the RSPBA increase its current Instructor Resource and be well placed to increase its Educational Activity covering PDQB Levels 1 – 4 and Pipe Band Studies 1 and 2 next winter session.
