Instructors Management Team

To aid and support an accredited team of “**Approved Education Instructors**”, it is a fundamental need to have in place an Instructors Management Team. This Team’s responsibility will be to prepare, support and encourage Instructors to a strong competency level.

This “**Approved Education Instructors**” Team will be charged with the responsibility to teach within the RSPBA environment thus furthering education and "encouraging" Student participation / preparation around PDQB Examination processes.

The Instructors Management Team will:

- Report to the RSPBA Music Board via the Education Convenor and Education Coordinator
- Develop and present an Instructors Course
- Develop and present ongoing development and improvement activity
- Provide support to the “Approved Education Instructors”
- Provide Educational Support Resources
- Review, develop and update the Association’s educational manuals to ensure integrity and compliance to achieve PDQB examination standards.

The Instructors Leadership Commitment:

- It is anticipated that the Team will consist of 5 people.
- The Education Convenor, the Education Coordinator plus 3 Members. (In addition, the Music Board Convenor will have the right of attendance and participation in all activity).
- The members currently are Tom Brown, Jim Wark, Jim Campbell Peter Snadden and Colin Smith.
- The team is permitted to invite internal/external presenters to participate in courses/training/development activity as it feels appropriate.
- Course commitment will be shared over 2 weekends running March and September 2009.
- It is anticipated there will be a course needed every 2 years with one day workshop requirement in intervening years.
