#### **About me:**

I was born in 1952 beginning my Piping at the age of 8 with the 47<sup>th</sup> Culter Boys Brigade. I continued my involvement with the 47<sup>th</sup> as an officer and Captain until 5 years ago. In 1966 I achieved my ambition of membership with Bucksburn and District Pipe Band and played there until 1983. During my time with Bucksburn, 10 years were grade 1 and the remainder Grade 2. I was Pipe Sergeant in Bucksburn for the last 5 years.

In 1978 I became Pipe Major of the 47<sup>th</sup> Culter Boys Brigade Pipe Band who competed for the first time in 1980 in Novice Juvenile Grade. In 1985, that Novice Band achieved Grade 2 status under my leadership.

I achieved Advance Certificate in 1978 and Instructors in 1979. In January 1998 I was appointed as a Piping Adjudicator. January 1999 saw my appointment to the Music Board representing the North of Scotland Branch. Now living in Glasgow, I resigned from the Branch in November 2008 but was co-opted to the Music Board as Education Coordinator.
