Entries Close Friday 30th June 2018. The draw for order of play will take place on Sunday 1st July 2018
 Entry Fees: All band grades **£10.00**. Adult Drum Majors **£5.00** Juvenile Drum Majors **£0.00**

Grade 4 will submit and play 1 selection of 2¾ - 4½ minutes duration
 Grade 3 will submit and play 1 selection of 3 - 5 minutes duration.
 Grade 2 will submit and play 1 selection of 4 - 6 minutes duration.

Bands will be notified of their draw time. **No late entries will be accepted.** Grade 4 contest starts at approx 2.00pm, (may be changed at the promoters discretion)

Band representatives are responsible for their band being at the **Final Tuning Area**. Stewards are available to assist.

All bands are requested to take part in the March Past and Prizes will be awarded after the march past of massed bands.

Any band may be asked to play for the Drum Major's contest.

All trophies MUST be returned to the promoter not less than 1 MONTH prior to the following years contest or a fine of £50 per trophy will be enforced and suspension from all RSPBA events until the trophy is returned and the fine paid.
