4. Bands may play one grade higher. If time permits.

7. Late entries will be accepted and bands will be asked to play first.
8. Any band requiring a coach pass must indicate on the online entry where applicable.
9. For bands not requesting a bus pass, 4 complimentary car passes may be provided. All other cars using the official car park **must** pay the parking fee as required.
10. Bands may be asked to play for Drum Majors.
11. Bands are expected to take part in the March Past.
