3. **Entry Fees: All Grades £10.00, Adult D/M's £5.00, Juvenile D/M's £Free**
4. Bands may play one grade higher, if time permits.
5. Closing date for entries is 9th August.
6. Draw will take place electronically on 12th August and will be posted on the following websites:
www.rspba.org and www.rspba-landb.org
7. Late entries will be accepted and bands will be asked to play first.
8. Any band requiring a coach pass must indicate on the online entry where applicable.
9. Bands may be asked to play for Drum Majors.
10. Bands are expected to take part in the Street Parade and March Past.
