### **CONTEST INFORMATION & RULES**

- All competitors must be registered members of an RSPBA pipe band or Overseas Pipe Band Association that is registered with the RSPBA.**
- All competitors must wear band uniform.
- An entrants' competitive section will be determined by his/her age as of **1<sup>st</sup> NOVEMBER 2018.** These are as follows:

<b>SECTION</b>	<b>CRITERIA</b>	<b>PLAYING REQUIREMENTS</b>
<b>1</b>	Aged under 14 years on the 1 <sup>st</sup> November 2018 and registered with a Band Novice Juvenile or Grade 4.	8 Parts of Quick March tempo in 2/4 time signature, tunes from the RSPBA Approved List
<b>2</b>	Aged 14, 15, 16, 17 years on the 1 <sup>st</sup> November 2018 and registered with a Band Novice Juvenile or Grade 4.	8 Parts of Quick March tempo in 2/4 time signature, tunes from the RSPBA Approved List
<b>3</b>	Aged under 14 years on the 1 <sup>st</sup> November 2018 and registered with a Band Grade Novice Juvenile A, Grade 4A, Juvenile, Grade 3, Grade 2 or Grade 1.	March, Strathspey and Reel of own choice. Minimum of FOUR parts each tune.
<b>4</b>	Aged 14, 15 years on the 1 <sup>st</sup> November 2018 and registered with a Band Grade Novice Juvenile A, Grade 4A, Juvenile, Grade 3, Grade 2 or Grade 1.	March, Strathspey and Reel of own choice. Minimum of FOUR parts each tune.

SECTION	CRITERIA	PLAYING REQUIREMENTS
5	Aged 16, 17 years on the 1 <sup>st</sup> November 2018 and registered with a Band Grade Novice Juvenile A, Grade 4A, Juvenile, Grade 3, Grade 2 or Grade 1.	March, Strathspey and Reel of own choice. Minimum of FOUR parts each tune.
6	Aged 18 years and over on the 1 <sup>st</sup> November 2018	<p><b>Playing Requirements</b></p> <p>Players are to submit two MSR's.</p> <p>a) In qualifying heats, the MSR to be played will be drawn on the line. This matches the format for the pre-qualifying events.</p> <p>b) In the semi-final, the MSR to be played will be drawn on the line.</p> <p>c) In the final, the MSR to be played will be players second MSR not played in the semi-final.</p> <p>The format of the Hornpipe and Jig Final, will be two four parted hornpipes and two four parted jigs. The player should demonstrate knowledge of both the Dot / Cut and Open rhythm (/idioms) within their performance of the hornpipes. Hornpipes to be played in set order of Dot and Cut first.</p>

**All competitors are confined to one event only.**

Players from 'Novice A' or '4A' bands may select to enter either section 1/2 (Marches) or section 3/4/5 (MSR) dependant on age.

Once a competitor has entered the MSR they cannot revert to the Marches sections in any future World Solo Drumming event.
